The jumping course will be a combination of natural show jumps and cross country jumps.

Combined Test: Green as Grass 12"-18" (USDF Intro B)
Maiden –18"- 2' (2010 Beginner Novice Test A)
Beginner Novice – 2'-2'6" (2010 Beginner Novice Test A)
Novice – 2'.6"-2'11" (2010 Novice Test A)
Training – 2'11"-3'3" (2010 Training Test A)

Hunter Derby 12"-18", 18"- 2', 2'-2'6", 2'.6"-2'11", 2'11"-3'3", 3'6" Starts at 9am Low to high
CT riders may cross entry Hunter Derby, **but** first round must be for CT (Event riders do not school their horses first)

Fees: Dressage: \$30
Combined Test: \$50
Hunter Derby: \$45 division - 2 trips and a flat class – all on **grass** (pre entry not required)
Open cross country schooling: \$30 (pre entry not required)

Refund policy: After closing date, less \$5 if filled from a waiting list, Full refund for open schooling.
